Medicon Cough Suppressant Syrup Pro is a non-narcotic antitussive drug that exerts excellent effects against the distressing symptoms of **cough and sputum** by the actions of 2 active ingredients: dextromethorphan hydrobromide hydrate that acts directly on the cough center to suppress cough, and potassium cresolsulphonate that facilitates sputum expectoration.

Precautions



When not to use the product

(If you do not follow these instructions, the current symptoms may worsen or adverse reactions/incidents are more likely to occur.)

- This product should not be taken in the following persons.

 Patients who have had an allergic symptom to this drug or its ingredients.
- This drug should not be taken together with the following drugs:
 Other antitussives and expectorants, cold medicines, sedatives, internal medicines, etc. containing antihistamines (internal medicine for rhinitis, medicine for motion sickness, medicine for allergies, etc.)
- After taking this drug, do not drive a car nor operate machinery (sleepiness may occur).



Consultation

- The following persons should contact a physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation before administration.
 - (1) Patients undergoing medical treatment from a physician
 - (2) Pregnant women or women suspected of being pregnant
 - (3) Patients who have experienced allergic symptoms associated with drugs, etc.
 - (4) Persons with the following symptom: hyperthermia
- If the following symptoms are observed after taking this drug, these may be adverse reactions, so immediately discontinue the use of this drug, and show this document to your physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation.

Dosage and administration

Take the following dose amount 3 times a day. Take this medicine in intervals of at least 4 hours.

 Strictly follow the prescribed dosage and administration.

Age	Single dose
Adults (15 years old and over)	6 mL
Children under 15 years old	Not allowed to take this medicine

A safety cap that cannot be easily opened by children is used for the container.

Open the cap by turning 1 to ounterclockwise while pushing it downward.

How to use the safety cap

Correct oral intake method

Place the mouth of the bottle onto the edge of the measuring cup and pour a single dose amount (6 mL) of the drug solution into the cup. Only the specified dose amount must be taken at one time.

Precautions for storage and handling

Medicon Cough Suppressant Solution Pro is a clear, pale yellowish-brown, viscous solution, containing the following

Additives include ethanol, sucrose, caramel, benzoic acid, sodium hydroxide, benzyl benzoate, ethyl

Store in a cool, low humidity place away from direct sunlight.

Ingredients and amounts

amounts of ingredients per 18 mL of the solution (the daily dose for adults):

(2) Keep out of reach of children.

Potassium cresolsulphonate

Ingredient

Dextromethorphan hydrobromide hydrate

vanillin, glycerin, vanillin, and flavoring

- (3) Do not transfer the medicine to a different container. (It may lead to misuse or alter the quality of the drug.)
- (4) Wash the measuring cup with water after each use and keep it clean.
- (5) When closing the cap, thoroughly wipe the mouth of the bottle. If the cap is closed with some drug solution attached to the mouth of the bottle, this may cause the cap not to be easily opened at the next use. If the cap is not tightly closed, this may cause leakage or contamination of the solution from the bottle.
- (6) If the cap is not easily opened, turn the bottle over and immerse the cap in hot water (50°C to 60°C) to enable opening easily.
- (7) Do not take the product after its expiration date
